Activities Day - Friday 19th July 2019

As you will be aware, students are rewarded throughout the academic year through the awarding of House points from teachers, tutors and other staff members. Students have now been awarded a reward 'status' which corresponds to our activities day.

Students' status is based upon the number of House points they have received in Terms 1 to 5 as well as their attendance and behaviour. We recognise and reward good attitude to learning, attendance and behaviour throughout the year according to our rewards system. This includes prize draws, rewards events, presentation of certificates and celebrating together in termly awards assemblies.

In addition to this, we have the end of year Activities Day to reward students for their hard work this year. This will take place on Friday 19th July and will include a range of on-site activities and, for students who have attained an attitude to learning status of silver or better, a choice of off-site activities.

The accompanying Activities Day Booklet, which can also be found on the Academy website and through SMHW, outlines the choice of activities on offer. This includes approximate costs and timings, including a variety of free activities available at the Academy.

Students have been asked to indicate their 1st, 2nd and 3rd choice preferences through a quiz that they have been set on SMHW. Students have until Monday 20th May 2019 to make their selections. If you encounter any difficulty in successfully logging into SMHW and completing the quiz, students need to raise the issue with their tutor who will direct them to further support. We will aim to give everyone their first-choice activity but this may not be possible due to the number of places available and the logistics of coach travel.

We do not require any money at this stage. Once we have everyone's preferences, we will be able to confirm which activity your son/daughter will be taking part in and then provide details of payment.
